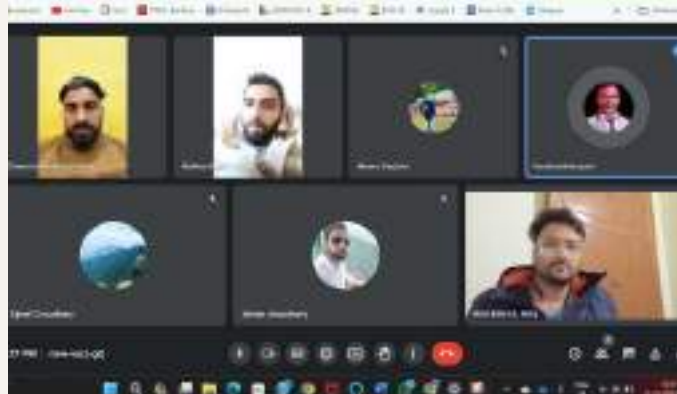
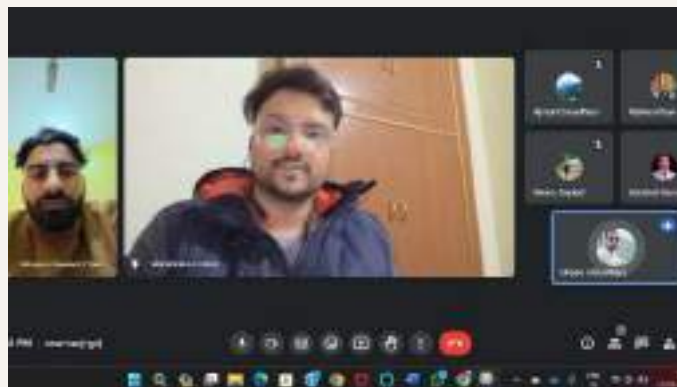
ONLINE MEETING

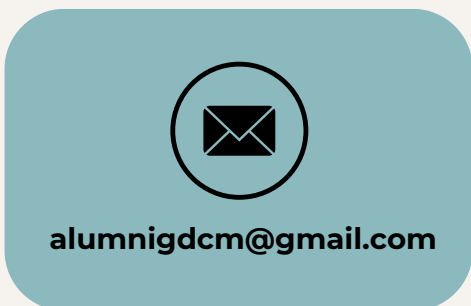
