BIOLOGICAL TOUR





Departments of Zoology and Botany under the supervision of Prof. Sarshad Hussain, HoD Zoology and Dr. Mahroof Khan HoD Botany conducted five day tour w.e.f *1*st *Nov.*, to 5th *Nov.*, 2013 for the students of B.Sc. Part-II and III to Jammu and adjoining areas.

On first day the tour party visited the Botanical garden University of Jammu, Jammu. Dr. Harish Chander Dutt, a renowned Taxonomist discussed about the Botanical garden that was arranged as per the Bentham and Hoooker system of classification. Meanwhile the students also visited green house and studied the plant species. There after the students visited the research laboratory of plant reproduction where Prof. Amjad Ali discussed the flowering phenology of *Hippophae rhamnoides* (Seabuckthorn) -as a reservoir of numerous chemical compounds of medicinal, nutraceutical and cosmaceutical values. In Plant Pathology laboratory Dr. Rohani Sharma highlighted the importance of fungitheir

utility and also discussed the techniques for its culture. In the central lab facility Dr. Harish Chander Dutt familiarized the students with various high tech instruments used to study biomolecules.

There after students were carried to Animal and Poultry farm Balicharana where they were introduced by the experts about types of breeds, rearing technique, diseases and their control. In the evening the students visited the SKAUST University at Chhatha where Dr. Javaid Ahmed explained various biotech methods used in the characterization and development of new varieties.

On 2nd day students visited Environmental Park, where Dr. Mahroof Khan, HoD Botany explained the students about all the tree species growing in Jammu Shiwaliks either native or introduced that were planted in the park.

Then the students were taken to tourist spots; Patnitop and Sanasar for cultural, aesthetic and recreational values.


INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY
