


SAIR-E-WATAN




Local Environmental Awareness Tour

Department of Mathematics organised extension lecture in which Dr. Abdul Rahoof, HoD Mathematics, PG College Rajouri and Prof. Tehseen Abbas, HoD Mathematics, GDC Poonch enlightened the students about the importance of mathematics. They also told some tricks used to solve the problems of mathematics. At the end Prof. Sumaira, HoD Mathematics of the host college presented vote of thanks.





Department of Hindi Dr. B.B Sharma, Principal GDC Thannamandi delievered an extension lecture on importance of Hindi language in connection with the celeberation of Hindi Diwas which is celeberated on 14th Sept. He told that Hindi is our national language and official language of north India and it is the second most spoken language in the world. This is the language which has united all the different relegions and regions of India together. He also spoke on Hindi grammar (Vayakaram) and the origin of Hindi language. He stressed upon the audiance to recognise the importance of Hindi language and use it in daily life.







Department of Persian organised a lecture in which Dr. Nahim, HoD Persian GDC Thannamandi was the key speaker. He spoke in length about the origin and development of the language over the period of time. He impressed upon the students not to take this subject casually and asked them to develop a thorough interest in it. He appreciated good enrolement of students in this subject in this region.





Department of Chemistry organised an extension lecture in which Prof. Tajinder Singh, Principal GDC Poonch, delivered an extension lecture on chemical kinetics and its scope. He said chemical kinetics is an integral part of metabolic process and is very important in industrial processes of food manufacturing and preservation. He discussed at length that kinetics studies have contributed to the development of large number of new materials and products efficiently at much lower cost and helped in achieving the economy of scale. He discussed that study of the kinetics of atmospheric reactions have led to our understanding of the chemistry of ozone depletion in stratosphere and acid rain in troposphere. He concluded that chemical kinetics is not only a fundamental science of pure academic interest but is of great importance in industrial and life processes. The lecture was attended by almost all the students. Among the faculty members Prof. Shoket Hussain, HoD Chemistry, Prof Zafar Iqbal, Dr. Mahroof Khan. Prof Qasim Mir were present. At the end vote of thanks were presented by Prof. Shoket Hussain.





Department of Geography also organised an extension lecture on the same day in which Prof. Khadim Hussain, Hod geography, GDC Poonch was the invited speaker. He delivered a lecture on the teaching skills. With the help of examples he explained that how subject can be made more interesting by using various audio visual aids as well as field study trips.
