



NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY (NEP) 2020

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 marks a transformative shift in India's educational landscape. Aiming to make education more holistic, flexible, and multidisciplinary, NEP 2020 emphasizes creativity, critical thinking, skill development, and learner-centric approaches at all levels.

At SCS Government Degree College, Mendhar, we are committed to implementing NEP 2020 in both spirit and practice. The college has restructured its curriculum since academic session 2022-23 to align with the policy's Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) model, offering students multiple entry and exit options and a blend of academic and vocational courses.

Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP 2020 follows a Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS), offering students flexibility, academic mobility and a multidisciplinary approach.

Key Features of the FYUGP Structure:

- Multiple Entry & Exit Options
- Credit-based Progression (as per UGC guidelines)
- Emphasis on Major, Minor, Multidisciplinary, Skill-based and Value-Added Courses
- Internships / Field Projects / Research integrated from Year 3/4
 (Sem V/VII) onwards

Course Components per Semester

- Major (Discipline Core)
- Minor (Elective from Other Discipline/subject of same stream)
- Multidisciplinary (From Stream other than Core/Major subject)
- Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)
- Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)
- Value-Added Courses (VAC)
- Internship/Research/Project (4th Year)

This structure is designed to give students the **freedom to design their own** academic path, blending traditional knowledge with modern skills and values.

The undergraduate degree should be of either a three year or four-year duration, with multiple entry and exit options within this period. The four years bachelor's programme is the preferred option as it allows the opportunity to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary

education with a focus on major and minor subjects as per the student's preference. The undergraduate programmes shall extend over four academic years (eight semesters). The students can exit after the completion of one academic year (two semesters) with the certificate, diploma after the study of two academic years (four semesters) and regular bachelor degree after the completion of three academic years (six semesters). A candidate who successfully completes a three-year bachelor's degree with minimum CGPA of 7.5 and wishes to pursue the fourth year of the undergraduate programme shall be allowed to continue the programme to obtain the bachelor's degree with honours/research.

Programmes Structure

Shri Chhote Shah Government Degree College, Mendhar offers a wide range of undergraduate programmes under the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) aligned with **NEP 2020**. Students have the flexibility to choose combinations across **major**, **minor**, and **multidisciplinary** subjects, along with **value-based** and **skill-enhancement** courses.

- Major Course (MJ): Any subject in a discipline in which student wants to graduate for 3 years bachelor degree or 4 years bachelor degree with honours/research.
- **Minor Course (MI):** Any subject other than major available in the college/offsite campus from any discipline.
- Multidisciplinary Course (MD): Any subjects of student's choice which is of interdisciplinary nature from faculties other than major with the condition that the subject opted for shall not be repeated in any semester

- Ability Enhancement Course (AE): It may be modern Indian language (MIL), English language (general), communication skill, mathematical ability MIL includes Hindi /Urdu
- Skill Enhancement Course (SE): The courses shall be chosen from the basket of courses from NSQF as notified by the university of Jammu The university departments/respective board of studies can propose new courses in addition to NSQF
- Value Added Courses (VA): Four compulsory courses are:
 - (a) Understanding India
 - (b) Environmental Science and Education
 - (c) Digital Technology
 - (d) Health and Wellness

In addition, following optional value added courses shall be offered by the college subject to the availability of faculty/infrastructure:

- Community Engagement
- National Cadet Corp (NCC)
- National Service Scheme (NSS)
- Bharat Scouts and Guides
- Sports
- Cultural
- Yoga
- **Summer internship**: It shall be a short-term internship of duration 15 days in 5th semester for job professional training in a suitable

organization or hands on training or activity-based course at college level to get work experience. Internship shall under a college teacher who designated as Internship Supervisor. After completion of summer internship students will have to produce a report related to the work carried out.

• Research project/Dissertation: Project work is considered a unique course involving applying knowledge in solving analyzing exploring a real-life situation/complex problem/data analysis. Project work has the intention to provide research competencies at the undergraduate level. It enables the acquisition of special advanced knowledge through support study/a project work. This course is applicable to students in 8" semester of undergraduate research program. A separate guideline shall be issued with regard to the evaluation of the Research project/Dissertation.

Credit Plan of FYUGP

1. Major Course

Each student will study for

- ➤ 62 Credits in Major for Three Years Graduation.
- ➤ 94 Credits in Major for Four Years Graduation (Honours).

Major Course can be any subject chosen from the following disciplines:

- Science (list of subject given above)
- Arts and Humanities (list of subject given above)

2. Minor Course

Each student will study:



- ➤ 24 credits of minor course in same subject for three year graduation from 1 to 6 semester (4) credits in each semester)
- ➤ 32 credits of minor course in same subject for four year graduation (honours) (research)

3. Multidisciplinary Courses from other disciplines (Foundation Courses)

➤ 09 Credits of multidisciplinary courses of 03 credits each from 1 to 3 semesters from disciplines other than major with the condition that the subject opted for shall not be repeated in any semester

4. Ability Enhancement Courses

- ➤ Modern Indian Languages (MIL) Hindi/Urdu/English language, (General). Communication Skills and Mathematical Ability.
- > 09 Credits of AEC Courses of 03 Credits each from 1 to 3 Semester

5. Skill Enhancement Courses

➤ 06 Credits of Skill Enhancement Courses (SE) of 02 Credits each from 1 to 3 Semester The courses shall be chosen from the basket of courses from NSQF as notified by the University of Jammu

ADMISSION PROCESS

Admissions in BA/BSc programmeat Shri Chhote Shah Government Degree College, Mendhar are conducted strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of Jammu & Kashmir, under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 framework.

Eligibility Criteria:

 Applicants must have passed the Higher Secondary Part II (12th Class) examination from JKBOSE or any other recognized board.

Admission Procedure:

1. Online Registration:

Candidates must apply through the official portal of J&K
 Higher Education Department.

2. Document Verification:

- Submit required documents in original along with photocopies:
 - Marksheets (10th & 12th)
 - Domicile Certificate
 - Category Certificate (if applicable)
 - Passport-sized photographs



3. Merit List & Counseling:

- Admission is granted strictly on merit basis (in common entrance test or qualifying examination) as per subject and stream combinations.
- o Counseling and subject allotment will be held at the college.

4. Fee Payment & Confirmation:

On selection, students must pay the prescribed admission fee
 within the notified period to confirm their seat.

Important:

- Students should keep track of admission notifications through the official website or college notice board.
- Any incomplete or incorrect information may lead to disqualification.
- Reservation policy will be followed as per **government norms**.

Promotion/Admission to next semesters

Promotion/admission to BA/BSc sem III and V will be granted to the students who have:

- i) Passed at least 50% credits in semester I/III
- ii) Passed in internal assessment examination of all subjects in Sem II/IV as the case may be.



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- ✓ **Ragging is strictly prohibited** both on and off campus. Any student found involved will face strict disciplinary action under law.
- ✓ Use of drugs and smoking is strictly forbidden.
- ✓ **Subjects once opted cannot be changed** after admission.
- ✓ Damaging or defacing college property will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- ✓ Mobile phones are not allowed on the campus during working hours.
- ✓ Wearing the college uniform is mandatory on all working days.

 Students without uniform will not be permitted on campus.
- ✓ During free periods, students should utilize the **library for academic** activities.
- ✓ Unauthorized absence from classes will result in disciplinary action.
- ✓ Students must carry their identity cards at all times on campus.
- ✓ **Absence for more than two consecutive weeks** may lead to cancellation of admission.
- ✓ No student is allowed to bring **outsiders onto campus** without prior permission.
- ✓ Spitting on walls, corridors, or common areas is strictly prohibited.
- ✓ Students with **attendance below 75%** will not be eligible for scholarships or to appear in final examinations.
- ✓ Participation in strikes or disruptive activities may lead to withdrawal of scholarships.



IDENTITY CARD

- 1. Identity cards will be issued upon admission and must be carried at all times.
- 2. Loss of the card must be reported immediately to the college office.
- A duplicate card may be issued on payment of ₹100, along with an affidavit on ₹10 non-judicial stamp paper attested by a Magistrate/Notary.
- 4. I-cards must be returned at the end of each academic session. Failure to do so will incur a fine of ₹200.

 - d) **Undertaking:** Parents must agree to refund scholarship money if the student engages in disruptive activities.
